Once your deposit is received, Queen's will automatically request your Provincial Attestation Letter (PAL) if required.

Receive Your Documents

- 📌 Download your PAL from SOLUS once available.
- 📌 Check your email for your Letter of Acceptance (LOA).

Both documents are required to apply for your Study Permit!

Apply for your Study Permit as soon as you receive your LOA and PAL.
